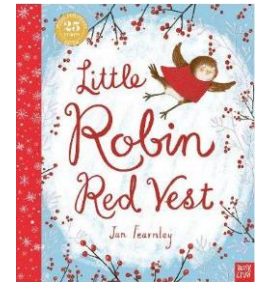
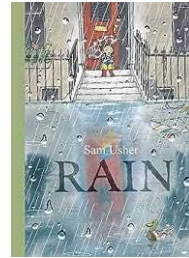
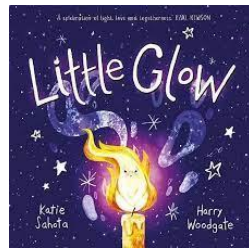

<p>Literacy Nursery & Reception Enjoy making marks freely Attribute meaning to the marks they make Listening games, songs and rhymes Recognise & write own name Draw with increased accuracy Make labels, Christmas list for Santa</p> <p>Reception Learn set 1 sounds using Read, Write, Inc Learn letter formation rhymes, write recognisable letters, most of which are correctly formed Spell words by identifying sounds in them and representing the sounds with correct grapheme in line with phonic knowledge Pencil grip Write labels, Christmas list for Santa</p>	<p>Maths Nursery Sing number rhymes & count in play Subitise to 3 Cardinal principle & correspondence to 5 Ordinality of numbers to 5</p> <p>Reception Counting, ordinality and cardinality of numbers to 10</p> <p>Comparison – more/fewer/same Composition of numbers – parts and whole Sing number rhymes and count in everyday play Link numeral to amount – 1:1 correspondence Use of manipulatives such as Numicon to show understanding of number Subitising Finger counting Build with blocks and notice patterns</p>
