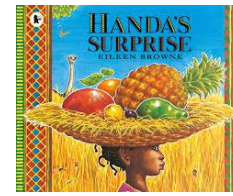
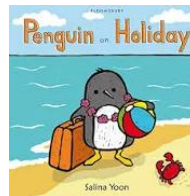

<p>Understanding the World Nursery and Reception</p> <p>Explore different climates in different Countries around the world Different animals live in different Habitats. Some are hot and some are cold. Some animals live in water and some on land. We can travel around the world using different modes of transport We can use maps to find our way around different places</p> <p>Expressive Arts and Design Nursery & Reception Use materials and tools provided to build models of different types of transport</p> <p>People and Communities What can we learn from stories from other cultures?</p>	<p>Communication and Language Nursery</p> <p>Develop listening and attention skills Understand simple questions and offer simple explanations using new vocabulary learnt from fiction and non fiction texts develop familiarity with new knowledge and vocabulary</p> <p>Reception</p> <p>Ask questions to check understanding Articulate ideas in well-formed sentences Engage in fiction and non-fiction books Participate in discussion Use talk to organise and explain thinking Listen to and talk about selected non-fiction texts to develop familiarity and new knowledge and vocabulary</p>
<p>Personal, Social and Emotional Development Nursery and Reception</p> <p>Relationships How to make friends How to solve friendship problems when they occur Help others to feel part of a group How to show respect to our friends How can we help ourselves / our friends when we feel sad? What makes a good friendship?</p>	<p>Physical Development Nursery & Reception</p> <p>This terms focus is ball skills. We will explore different ways of using our hands to move with the ball and keep control. We will also begin to practise for sports day!</p> <p>Weekly Paddock School sessions, bikes and trikes, continue to develop pencil grip and letter formation. Manage self-care skills. Dominant hand preference with comfortable grip when writing and drawing.</p>
<p>Literacy Nursery</p> <p>Phase 1 listening Games, stories, songs and Rhymes. Begin to learn set 1 sounds Enjoy drawing freely with increased Accuracy. Write some / all letters of name Use some print / letter knowledge in early writing / play</p> <p>Reception</p> <p>Learn set 1, then set 2 sounds when ready Read and spell words by identifying sounds in them and representing the sounds with correct grapheme in line with phonic knowledge. Write simple phrases that can be understood by themselves and others in line with phonic knowledge. Write some common exception words.</p>	<p>Maths Nursery</p> <p>Sing number rhymes, count in their play Build with blocks and notice patterns Subitise and link numeral to amount to 5 Finger numbers to 5 Cardinal principle Create and extend simple patterns Describe a familiar route</p> <p>Reception</p> <p>Numbers to 10 and beyond Cardinality, counting, composition and 1:1 Correspondence Develop recall of number facts Calculation and patterning Odd, even and doubling numbers Describe a familiar route See BBO Maths</p>
