Assessment

- ▶ Self assessment
- ▶ Peer assessment
- ▶ Continuous assessment – monitoring by class teacher through observation, evaluation of work and end of unit tests
- ▶ Feedback in written and verbal form from class teacher

Work Expectations

- ▶ Neat and well presented
- ▶ Write to the margin
- ▶ Joined handwriting – the aim!
- ▶ Single line through errors
- ▶ Self edit – spellings, capital letters and full stops
- ▶ Acceptable amount of work for child's ability
