### Year One Parents

### Homework

- Please continue supporting your child with spellings and homework tasks, the children do benefit from taking responsibility for their learning when they are away from school, but it is important to strike a good balance between work, rest and fun!
- Year 2 children will be given homework tasks which will be handed out on Friday. All homework must be handed in on the following **Wednesday**.

- Spellings are set out in their mission folders and each child will be tested on Fridays. Both year groups are expected to read and practise their mission words and spellings every day. Please practise these at home.
- Please ensure you are reading daily with your child. Children are expected to change their own books and aim to write their own comments in their yellow journals. For younger children the adult reading with them should write in the journal.

### **Swimming - Detailed letter from Mrs. Hunt to follow**

We will be continuing our weekly swimming sessions on a Tuesday Morning. These sessions are not only brilliant fun and a vital skill for life, they are a great way to boost confidence and independence in our young children. KS1 is a perfect time to start swimming as children are open to new challenges and learn new physical skills quickly. The children are carefully assessed by our swimming instructors and put into structured ability groups.
