


**Here We Are

Curriculum Map
Term 1 2020 -2021**



English
As Readers and Authors we will focus on the text 'Here We Are' by Oliver Jeffers. We will focus on:

- * Write letters to ourselves and to someone special
- * Write a poem using our senses as a stimulus
- * debating skills
- * create fact files
- * create leaflets

We will develop our reading skills by focusing on:

- * making predictions using prior reading / knowledge
- * clarifying the meaning of new vocabulary

Art
As Artists we will be focusing on pencil skills and sketch the following:

- * look at 'our world' and sketch Burford Primary School
- * the moon
- * animal print (scales, fur etc)

We will also look at tones of colours in painting by:

- * using white to make a colour lighter and being able to make a colour darker

PE
As Athletes we will learn:

- * the importance of exercise
- * how to look after our bodies
- * ball skills – controlled kicking including dribbling, passing, receiving

Geography
As Geographers we will:

- * use world maps, atlases and globes to identify, name and label the continents and oceans
- * identify and label biomes around the world
- * look at the layers of the ocean and the sea creatures that live in each zone

Maths
As mathematicians we will secure our knowledge of place value which will include:

- * partitioning into hundreds, tens and ones and then up to 100,000
- * understanding the value of each digit
- * comparing and ordering numbers (including using inequality symbols, sequencing, number line work)
- * rounding numbers (nearest 10, 100, 1000)
- * decimals up to 2 decimal places
- * negative numbers

PSHE
We will consider and discuss:

- * getting on and falling out – how to deal with friendship issues
- * making new friends and playing together
- * identifying the feelings we have
- * identifying feelings others may have based on body language
- * what makes a great learner

Music
As Musicians we will:

- * listen to 'What a wonderful world' by Louis Armstrong and respond to how the song makes us feel

History
As Historians we will:

- * look at Neil Armstrong and the first moon landing

ICT
As programmers we will consolidate our knowledge on:

- * how to be safe on the internet
- * using Google Classroom
- * researching information on the internet

Science
As Scientists we will:

- * learn about respiratory hygiene and the importance of 'Catch it. Bin it. Kill it.'
- * learn about the importance of keeping healthy including physical and mental health
- * learn about the digestive system
- * learn about teeth in humans and animals
- * learn about oral hygiene
- * plan and carry out a simple experiment
- * learn about food chains
- * group animals into different classifications (herbivores, omnivores, carnivores) (mammals, amphibians, invertebrates, birds, reptiles, fish)
