



## Windrush Class

### Curriculum Map

Term 1 2021

#### English

As readers and authors we will focus on the text Errol's Garden by Gillian Hibbs and Dear Zoo by Rod Campbell.



We will:

- \*share responses to these books, using prediction, asking questions and making connections with our own experiences

- \*Explore narrative setting, plot and characters

- \*sequence events to write a short narrative based on a known story

In addition, we will also work on letter formation, using spaces between words and using known sounds. The Year 2s will also focus on sentence construction. This will include ensuring sentences start with a capital letter and end with either a full stop, question or exclamation mark.

#### Phonics

These lessons will follow the Read, Write, Inc approach.

#### Maths

As mathematicians, we will develop our place value knowledge by focusing on:

- \*the composition of numbers 1-10

- \*comparing measures and quantities using greater than, less than and equal to and relating this to number

- \*the whole of a number and how this number can be broken down into different parts

#### Science

As scientists, we will identify:

- \*common garden and wild plants

- \*deciduous and evergreen trees and what makes them so

- \*the structure of a flowering plant and a tree

- \*what a plant needs to grow strong and healthy

We will also learn about the lifecycle of a flowering plant.

#### Geography

As mathematicians, we will learn about:

- \*maps and their purpose, creating a map of our classroom

- \*the United Kingdom including its four regions and their capital cities

- \*the continents and oceans of the world

#### Art

As artists, we will create self portraits using a variety of different techniques and styles including:

- \*pencil drawings (our whole face and half)

- \* pop art (using bright colours to colour photographs of our faces)

- \* fabric collages

We will also create sculptures of the human body using wire and tin foil. In addition, we will study the artist Andy Gormley and create sculptures inspired by his work 'A field of the British Isles'.

#### ICT

As programmers, we will learn how to use a range of techniques to create a simple stop frame animation.

#### Music

As musicians, we will learn songs based on the story Jack and the Bean Stalk. We will also listen to a wide range of music and identify the mood it creates and the types of instruments playing.

#### PE

As athletes, we will develop our skills of catching, throwing and kicking. We will apply these skills to simple team games.
