## Prime Area – Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Express how we feel when change happens. Continue to build peer relationships and self-regulate.

## Prime Area – Communication and Language

Enjoy listening to stories and talk about what happens in them. Use new vocabulary in different contexts. Continue to develop range of rhymes, songs and stories. Develop understanding of who, what, when and why questions. Understand and follow simple instructions involving one and two parts.

## Specific Area - Understanding the World

Share and celebrate special occasions within our families and the families of other cultures. Hindu festival Diwali – the Festival of Light  
Christian Festival - Christmas



Paddock School – observe similarities and differences in the natural world



## Prime Area – Physical Development

Use mark making implements and scissors with increased control. Show a preference for a dominant hand. Write own name.

Continue to develop movement, balancing, riding (scooters, trikes and bikes) and ball skills. Skip, hop, stand on one leg and hold a pose for a game like musical statues. Become increasingly independent in meeting self-care skills. Develop and refine a range of ball skills including: throwing, catching, kicking, passing and aiming.

## Specific Area - Mathematics

Ordinality and cardinality of numbers to 5, then above. Choosing the correct number of objects to match these numerals and vice versa – 1:1 correspondence. Fast recognition of number of objects without counting them – subitising. Use of manipulatives to show understanding of number. Comparison of numbers and composition. Create rangoli patterns linking to topic work.

## Specific Area – Literacy

Continue to develop phonological awareness of single sounds and digraphs. Write some letters accurately.

Make party invitations for our celebration topic and make lists for Father Christmas!

Engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary.

## Specific Area - Expressive Arts and Design

Explore different materials, tools and techniques used to shape and create with different materials such as playdough, clay and cardboard. Engage in play using props available. Begin to develop stories through play using the small world and party role play area around Diwali and Christmas. Listen with increased attention to stories. Enjoy joining in with songs and rhymes.
