

English

As readers and authors we will focus on the text Look Up by Nathan Bryon.



As readers, we will:

*Consider the ways in which illustrations can deepen the meaning of a text

*Discuss the significance of the title and the key events within the story

*Begin to make simple inferences

*Retrieve specialist vocabulary

As writers, we will:

*Continue to work on letter formation, full stops and capital letters.

*Write a set of instructions

*Begin to use expanded noun phrases to add more detail

Phonics

These lessons will follow the Read, Write, Inc approach.

Those who have moved on from the Read Write Inc phonics scheme, will be focusing on making inferences and predictions about the books they are reading.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will focus on:

*Continuing to practice our number bonds to 10

*Continuing practicing counting in 2s, 5s, 10s

*Counting across and beyond 100

*Understanding place value when multiplying numbers by 10 or 100

* Beginning to practice counting in 3s and 4s

Science

As scientists, we will:

*identify what an object is and what material it is made from

*identify different materials such wood, plastic, glass, metal and rock

*describe the properties of materials and why they are used for specific objects

*find out how the shapes of solid objects can be changed by applying a force

Historians

As historians, we will learn about:

*the history of flight

*the history of space travel

*significant black females from flight and space travel

Design and Technology

As engineers, we will:

*learn how rockets work

*design and build our own water rocket

*experiment with different materials to find suitable ones to use in our rocket design

*test our rockets

*evaluate our design

ICT

As programmers, we will learn develop our understanding of what IT is and identify examples. We will consider where we have seen IT in school and beyond. The importance of using IT safely and responsibly will form a large part of our sessions.

Music

As musicians, we will continue to listen to a wide range of music from different time periods and cultures. We will learn and perform songs for an audience.

PE

As athletes, we will apply our agility and coordination to hockey. We will learn how to work together as a team and begin to understand the importance of working together in team games.
