Curriculum Map
Term 1 2022

English

This term we will focus on revisiting and embedding grammar skills from the previous year.

As writers, we will:

- *Ensure all sentences contain a capital letter, ending punctuation and finger spaces.
- *Learn about common nouns and proper nouns
- *Learn about verbs and begin to think about verb tense
- *Secure our understanding of what a sentence is and how to form them.
- *Secure our understanding of exclamation and question marks.

As readers, we will focus on:

- *Answering retrieval questions. These are questions where the children have to pick out information from a text.
- *Enjoying stories, poems and non-fiction texts that are read to us.

Phonics

These lessons will follow the Read, Write, Inc approach.. For children that have complete RWI, they will be taking part in daily comprehension sessions, where they will focus on their understanding of a text.

PE

As athletes, we will focus on fitness and develop our skills with speed, agility, balance and coordination. We will apply these skills to both football and handball. We will also consider the importance of working together as a team.

Science

As Scientists, we will:

Year 2: Materials

- *Describe how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.
- *Identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brock, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses.

Year 3: Rocks

- *Compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties.
- *Describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have live are trapped within rock.
- *Recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.

Art

As Artists we will learn:

- *About the colour wheel and colour mixing
 - *Identify complementary colours
 - *Identify cold and warm colours
- We will learn how these can be used to create contrast or depth in a picture or to create a mood.

Music

As musicians, we will continue to listen to a wide range of music. We will identify the mood it creates, the types of instruments used and the tempo. We will also learn a variety of songs.

History

As Historians we will be looking at the changes over time in transport. We will compare early cars and bicycles to modern cars and bicycles. In addition we will examine well-known types of boats from history such as Viking longboats and Egyptian reed boats. The children will briefly recap the history of flight and learn about the invention of steam railways.

Computing

As programmers, we will focus on:

Computing systems and networks— children will further develop their understanding of technology and how it can help them. They will become familiar with the different components of a computer and improve their keyboard and mouse skills. We will consider how to use technology responsibly.

RE

As a thinker we are going to explore the religion of Hinduism. In particular we will study the festival of Diwali.

Maths

This term we will focus on revisiting and embedding key number skills from the previous year.

This will include:

- *correct number formation
- *multiples of 10 up to 100
- *composition of numbers from 10-100
- *subtraction as difference

Addition and subtraction

- *two-digit and single-digit numbers
- * bridging 10
- *two-digit numbers and multiples of ten.
