English

As readers, we will focus on:

*** The Three Little Pigs**

- * Explaining our understanding of what we have read
- * Answering questions about a range of fairy tale texts


As writers, we will:

- * write a version of The Three Little pigs, changing the characters and the houses
- * Add onomatopoeic words
- * Write using past tense verbs correctly, spelling most of them correctly
- * Expanding nouns by adding adjectives

Phonics and reading

These lessons will follow the Read, Write, Inc approach.

Children who have completed the phonics scheme are now reading Big Cat books. They are also practicing comprehension skills in their reading sessions.



Science

Y2– Everyday materials

*Identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses.

Y3– Forces and magnets

- * Describe how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching
- * Compare how things move on different surfaces
- * Observe how magnets attract and repel each other
- * Describe magnets having two poles
- * Compare everyday objects and group them as magnetic or not

Art

As artists children will learn about basic colour theory by studying the colour wheel and colour mixing. It includes an exploration of primary and secondary colours and how artists use colour in their artwork.

ICT

As programmers children will learn about the use of technology, how to stay safe online and basic programming skills.

PE

As gymnasts, we will develop our balance, agility and coordination skills, while creating sequences of movements.

As Hockey players, we are going to develop our hand – eye coordination, passing and team work skills. We will apply these skills to game situations.

- * Understanding place value to 1000

Geography

They learn about the equator, hemispheres and continents and are introduced to the countries, capital cities and settlements of the United Kingdom. The children carry out simple fieldwork to find out about local physical and human features.
