



English

As readers, we will focus on:

*** The Three Little Pigs**

- * Explaining our understanding of what we have read

As writers, we will:

Y1

- *Continue to work on letter formation

- *Use the sounds we know to spell some words

- *Focus on writing simple sentences beginning to use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces

Y2

- * identify verbs and change them to the past tense

- *Rewrite the story of The Three Little Pigs , changing the characters and houses.

- *continue to apply knowledge of sentence structure and grammar features to make their sentences more interesting.

Music

As Musicians we are going to find the beat in arrange of musical pieces. We will also focus on listening, and singing,

Science

As scientists, we will:

Y1

- *Describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials.
- *Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials based on their simple physical properties

Y2

- *Identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses.
- *Describe how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing,

Art

As artists children will learn about basic colour theory by studying the colour wheel and colour mixing. It includes an exploration of primary and secondary colours and how artists use colour in their artwork.

ICT

As programmers children will learn about the use of technology, how to stay safe online and basic programming skills.

PE

As gymnasts, we will develop our balance, agility and coordination skills, while creating sequences of movements.

As Hockey players, we are going to develop our hand – eye coordination , passing and team work skills. We will apply these skills to game situations.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will focus on:

Y1

- *Additive structures , including how to partition numbers into parts and wholes.

- *Composition of numbers 6-10, including number names to 10.

Y2

- *Addition and subtraction with numbers that bridge 10

- *adding 3 single addends together in the most effective way

Geography

As Geographers children will learn about physical and human features, maps, cardinal compass points, and positional and directional language. They learn about the equator, hemispheres and continents and are introduced to the countries, capital cities and settlements of the United Kingdom. The children carry out simple fieldwork to find out about local physical and human features.

RE

Y1– As thinkers children will explore and compare reasons for celebrating Harvest and Christmas. They will also learn that not everyone celebrates the same festivals.

Y2- As thinkers children will explore a variety of ways people can express their religion through what they wear.
